FREE INSURANCE

For those of you who may not remember, the American Legion (thru the Legion Insurance Trust) offers \$1,000 in FREE Accidental Death and Dismemberment Insurance. This insurance is now also available to American Legion Auxiliary members. Note that if the accident happens while doing anything related to the American Legion (such as traveling to and from post meetings or working on Legion programs) the amount becomes \$5,000. In times past you had to renew every five years but that is no longer the case. When you sign up now it is valid for life as long as your membership dues are current. You can sign up at www.thelit.com or stop by the post and get a postcard to mail in.
