We are now at about 50% of our Legionnaire 2019 membership goal. Please RENEW soon. Auxiliary and SAL also. Thank you.

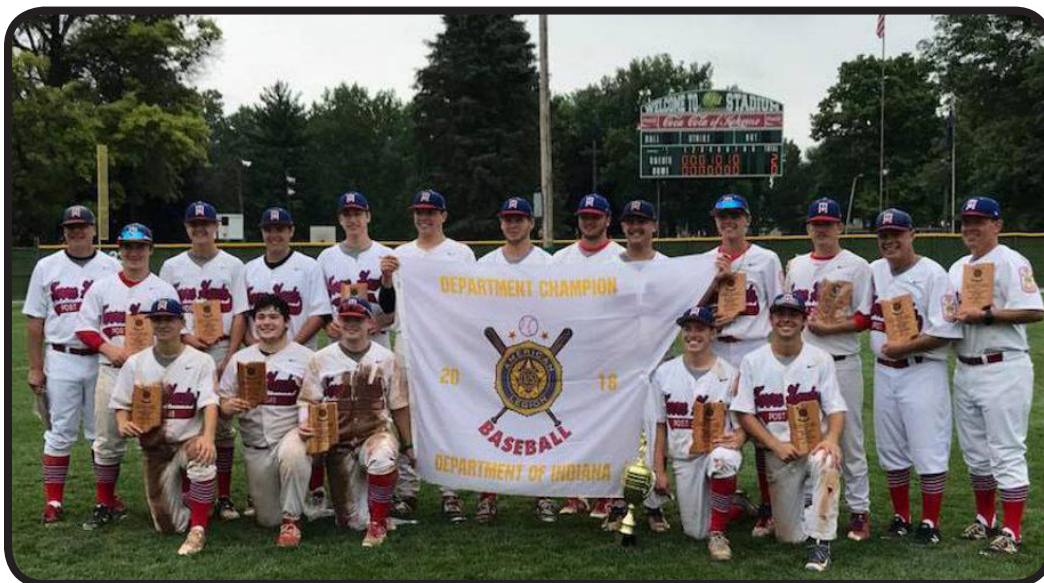
## FLU SHOTS!!
